Located at the St. Augustine Amphitheatre, the **BACKYARD STAGE** offers a unique setting, production and amenities for artists looking to play venues with a flexible 200-1,200 capacity crowd.

The stage is located in between the backstage area of the Amphitheatre and the State Park Arboretum. There is ample room to fit local food trucks, beer tents, merch areas and a sizeable crowd. The intimate vibe created is ideally that of a smaller venue appealing to the punk, indie, alt--country and hip--hop shows that are looking to play the NE Florida area. There is a large, growing audience of music lovers in the area and such a space will be greatly welcomed!

Being located onsite of the Amphitheatre means that artists will have full use of facilities and amenities offered at the Amphitheatre (dressing rooms, showers, laundry, Wi-Fi, shore-power for buses, etc.). Not only that, but the Amphitheatre staff will work above and beyond to make your artists feel comfortable, welcome and excited about the experience. 

The service road leading to backstage is located approximately 500' north of the main entrance on state road A1A.


Bus Parking & Shore Power

Two (2) buses (or additional trucks) can park in the alley immediately behind the main stage building. Shore power is available.



The **RED** rectangles indicate a parking spot typically used for a bus. Every **YELLOW** triangle represents an outlet for shore power.

Directions

The St. Augustine Amphitheatre is located on Anastasia Island in St. Augustine, Florida. The main entrance and box office are located at 1340C A1A South, St. Augustine, FL, 32080 For Semi's and Buses, use the service road at 1320 A1A South, St. Augustine, FL, 32080 (500' north of the marquee/main entrance on A1A.


Traveling North:

Take I-95 North to Exit 311 SR 207 North towards St. Augustine. Make a right onto SR 207 North and continue for 3.7 miles. Make a right onto SR 312 East towards St. Augustine Beach and continue for 3.6 miles. Make a left onto A1A North and continue for 1.1 miles. The St. Augustine Amphitheatre will be on your right.

Traveling South:

Take I-95 South to Exit 311 SR 207 North towards St. Augustine. Make a left onto SR 207 North and continue for 3.7 miles. Make a right onto SR 312 East towards St. Augustine Beach and continue for 3.6 miles. Make a left onto A1A North and continue for 1.1 miles. The St. Augustine Amphitheatre will be on your right.

*Please Note: This is the easiest path for semi's/buses. Other GPS routes will take you through downtown, a draw bridge, much smaller streets, and traffic.
